Ria Schaafsma was an early adopter of effective giving by using non-registered appreciated securities through the Christian School Foundation. Appreciated securities are publicly listed shares, mutual funds, exchange traded funds, and bonds that have increased in value.

While many people in Ria's generation have typically focused their giving through more traditional means, more and more of them are realizing - as Ria has - that they can have increased impact using this effective giving tool.




